

## TQ NODES, PORTALS FOR INPUT VALUES

#### IDENTITY NODE - Defined by external sources

• content for confirmation

#### VERIFICATION NODE - Defined by the TiiQu organization

• simple count of received verifications on all other nodes

#### REPUTATION NODE - Defined by trust sources sources (external and TiiQu organization)

- content for reputation rating
- processes to derive rating values
- rating range

#### PERFORMANCE NODE - Defined by TiiQu members and the TiiQu organization

Defined by TiiQu members:

• contract content for completing a mission

#### Defined by the TiiQu organization:

- minimal contract requirements to enable processes for a fair mutual rating after a completed mission
- processes to enable fair mutual rating after a completed mission
- · derive rating parameters from the defined processes
- assign rating values to the derived rating parameters

### Challenges for the TiiQu organization

The performance node poses the greatest challenge to introduce fairness into the trust quotient. It consists neither of simple yes/no questions nor of objective subjects. It is the responsibility of TiiQu to create basic conditions which enable a simple recording of the mission and a set of questions after its completion which

- can be answered with a simple yes/no and/or
- reduce subjectiveness to a minimum and enable the participants to look at the fulfilled mission with a clinical view
- allow an interactive discussion about the mutual ratings

To work this out, we need an expert(s) with skills in

- social science
- communication
- contracting
- process analysis and optimization

To continuously improve it we need experts with above skills and qualifications in

- algorithm development and implementation (Python, PHP etc.)
- knowledge of OpenID Connect and OAuth 2.0 APIs
- server administration
- statistics
